Cruising and Home Port Permit (Amendment of Schedule 2) Order, 2024

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 25(1)(a) of the Cruising and Home Port Permit Act, 2021, No. 9 of 2021, makes this Order.

Citation and commencement

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Cruising and Home Port Permit (Amendment of Schedule 2) Order, 2024.

(2) This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 2025.

Schedule 2 amended

2. Schedule 2 to the Cruising and Home Port Permit Act, 2021, No. 9 of 2021, is amended by deleting the table appearing after the heading “CLASSIFICATION FEES” and substituting the following table:
