

NAVIGATION WARNING NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 02-2025 (P)


OWNERS, MANAGERS, OPERATORS, SKIPPERS, AND MASTERS OF ALL VESSELS OPERATING WITHIN NORTH SOUND VIRGIN GORDA

REPORTED INCIDENT OF NAVIGATIONAL BUOY BREAKAWAY

LOCATION:

OYSTER ROCK BRITISH VIRGIN ISLANDS VG 18-29.667N 064-21.829W



Mariners are advised that the **Oyster Rock Red Buoy**, which marks a **submerged rock**, has broken free from its station and is currently **missing from its charted position**.

The buoy marks the rock located at the coordinates: Latitude 18°29.667'N, Longitude 64°21.829'W

This red buoy is a critical aid to navigation, marking the presence of a submerged hazard in the north sound area. The absence of this buoy poses a **significant risk to safe navigation**, particularly in low visibility or for vessels unfamiliar with local waters. All mariners are urged to:

- Exercise extreme caution when navigating in this area, and
- Avoid direct passage over the charted coordinates.

Efforts are currently underway to recover and re-establish the buoy. A follow-up notice will be issued once this navigation aid is restored.
